In Tables 3.3 to 3.7 the counting rules used to calculate the number of *sexual offences* changed in 1993 to bring them in line with other offences and with the National Counting Rules established by the Australian Bureau of Statistics' National Crime Statistics Unit. *Sexual offences* are now based on the number of victims rather than the number of offences. Therefore, caution should be exercised when making comparisons with pre-1993 figures.
